1) Johnston Canyon Ice Walk



This activity **CANNOT** be booked together with Marble Canyon Snowshoeing.

Price includes: Professional hiking guide, transportation from Banff, ice cleats, trekking poles and hot chocolate & cookies.

Requirements: Bring warm, winter clothing, winter or hiking boots, coat and pants, hat and gloves. Sneakers or dressy shoes are strictly **NOT allowed**.

Highlights: Learn about the canyon's formation, pick out fossil corals in the rocks, and photograph the incredible **pillars of ice**.

- $\cdot\,$ Walk through the canyon bottom and over suspended catwalks.
- Witness the magic of **frozen waterfalls** in mid-stream; a short tunnel for a close-up look of the Johnston Canyon Lower Falls.
- Check out the Instagram-worthy "Cathedral of Ice" at the Johnston Canyon Upper Falls.

2 Marble Canyon Snowshoeing



This activity **CANNOT** be booked together with Johnston Canyon Ice Walk.

Price includes: Professional guide, transportation from Banff, snowshoes, hiking poles and hot chocolate & maple taffy treat.

Requirements: Bring photo ID, base layers, snow pants, winter jacket (ideally waterproof), hat, gloves, and winter, waterproof boots. Sneakers or dressy shoes are strictly **NOT allowed**. Clothing rentals are available in Banff. **Highlights:** An easy introduction to snowshoeing in the picturesque Kootenay National Park. It's a great way to immerse yourself in the **winter wonderland**!.

- Admire the dramatic icy colours of Marble Canyon, worn away over centuries by the rushing waters of Tokumn Creek.
- \cdot Search for snowshoe hare, moose and **wolf tracks** while exploring the ever-changing landscape.
- Enjoy a uniquely Canadian treat: hot maple taffy poured into snow a sweet frozen dessert!

3 Banff Gondola (Sulphur Mountain)



This activity CAN be booked together with a DAY 3, MORNING activity.

Price includes: Transportation from Banff, round-trip gondola ride and 1.5-2 hours to explore at your own pace. **Requirements:** Dress warm. Winter clothing and hiking boots are strongly recommended.

Highlights: Experience a world of adventure and beauty at the summit of Banff's Sulphur Mountain.

- Enjoy panoramic views while sitting in a glass-enclosed **4-person** gondola cabin.
- Climb up 698 meters in altitude in a mile-long line from the bottom to the top, approximately an 8-minute ride each way.
- Soak up the breathtaking **360-degree views of the iconic Canadian Rockies** on top of the summit, and walk the outdoor boardwalk to the historic Sulphur Mountain Weather Station.
- Explore the indoor interpretive centre and theatre on top of the summit.





4) Ski / Snowboard at Lake Louise Mountain Resort





This activity CANNOT be booked together with any other optional activity.

Price includes: Full-day lift ticket and pick-up from resort at the end to continue with the tour. Free shuttle is available from Banff in the morning. The equipment rental package includes skis and ski poles or snowboard, boots and helmet.

Requirements: Wear ski/board clothing, including base layers, warm sweater, waterproof jacket, snow pants, thick socks, hat, neckwarmer and waterproof gloves. Also bring sunscreen, goggles or sunglasses and a helmet. **Highlights:** Enjoy a full day of skiing or snowboarding on **one of the best mountains in the Rockies**. Feel the thrill that comes from exploring Lake Louise Ski Resort's unique layout of ski runs.

- Ski/Board in over 4,200 acres of diverse terrain over four mountain faces.
- Choose from 7 chair lifts and 164 runs to ski/board the longest run expands over 8km and access the back bowls
 and West Bowl to explore.
