Price includes: Roundtrip shuttle from Whistler Village (if booked) and a safe jumping experience.

Requirements: All participants must read and sign a Release of Liability Waiver Form prior to bungee jumping. Guests who are under 16 years old must have a parent or legal guardian sign the form. Weight limit is between 65 lbs (30 kg) and 300 lbs (136 kg) appoximately, and you must fit into the harness. Dress accordingly to the weather. Athletic footwear and comfortable clothing is recommended. Long hair should be tied back. Whistler Bungee has a zero tolerance policy for drugs and alcohol.

Notes: This is a very popular activity. We recommend securing your spot before your departure date. The jumper can bring a spectator - an additional \$20 will be charged for the shuttle space (limited spots available). Tandem jump is available if the combined weight doesn't exceed 300 lbs (136 kg), price per person is the same.

Highlights: Live this unforgettable experience and feel the exhilaration of jumping 160ft (50 meters) over the glacialfed Cheakamus River.
